OUR HISTORY

The Sandhills Antique Farm Equipment Club was formed in August 2000 by 6 charter members to preserve Harnett County's and the surrounding area's historical farming heritage. The Club has grown to approximately 50 families, and meets monthly under the direction of Club President, Alvin McArtan, and the Club officers.

In 2007 the Club began the development of 20 acres of leased Harnett County land named Sandhills Antique Farm Park, located south of the Government Center, off the end of Alexander Drive. The Park was ready for use in the Summer of 2008, but it continues to be a work in progress as new buildings and displays are added. Sandhills Antique Farm Park is also the site of the 2011 Harnett Regional Agricultural Fair.
